Killington Ski & Snowboard School will be hosting over 700 British teenagers of varying abilities from Feb. 11th - 16th and we will need additional staff to help with this influx the week of the Presidents holiday week. In the past, instructors from many ski areas and various organizations have joined our team to help us out while enjoying a busman's holiday.

I would appreciate any help that your members could give during this timeframe. The Adult Ski School supervisor John Hobbs and I will discuss compensation individually with each person, which is based on our pay scale, experience and credentials, and general knowledge of Killington. We will provide skiing privileges for this year, uniform jacket, food discounts and limited low cost lodging. Additionally, we offer ongoing training seminars conducted by our training staff (includes 10 PSIA/AASI Ed. Staff Members) to all pros. We need pros that are comfortable working with 13 -16 yr. old skiers and/or snowboarders, are professional, flexible, and enjoy teaching the same students for five to six days in a row.

Classes are formed based on ability within the assigned school, with groups of approximately 10 students. Our goal is to match pros with groups based on schedule and individual preferences as much as possible. The majority of schools start on Feb. 11th or 12th and they are here for five to six days with four to five hours of lessons each day.

This year Easter break is early and we will have another influx of UK schools during the last days of March first two weeks of April. In the past your members have shown they have a passion for this sport and I have witnessed them passing this down to our students they coach. Any person that would like to help this February or March/April would be welcomed and greatly appreciated.
